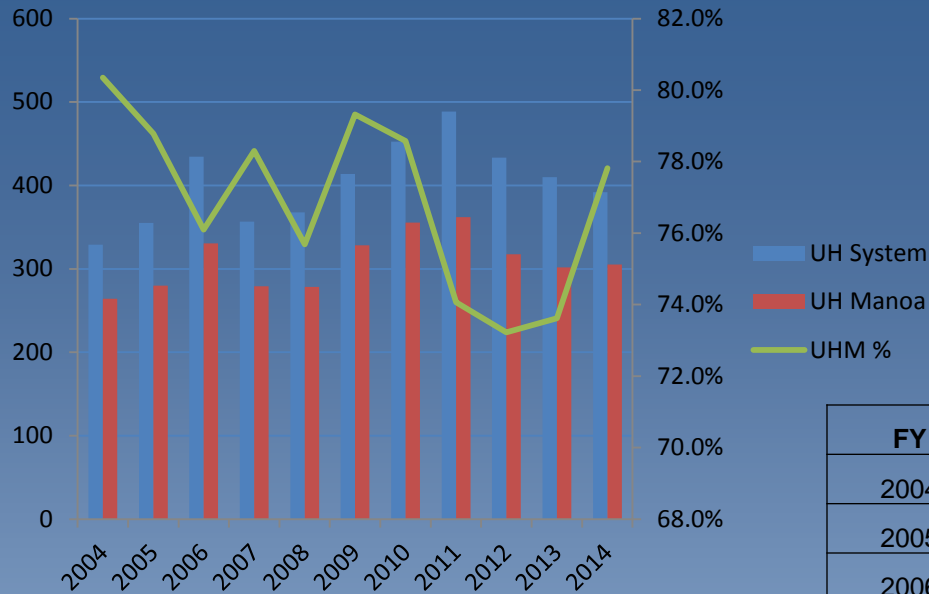
Land Grant, Sea Grant and Space Grant Institution – 10 Campuses

Pivot (Newest Generation Community of Science) search tools

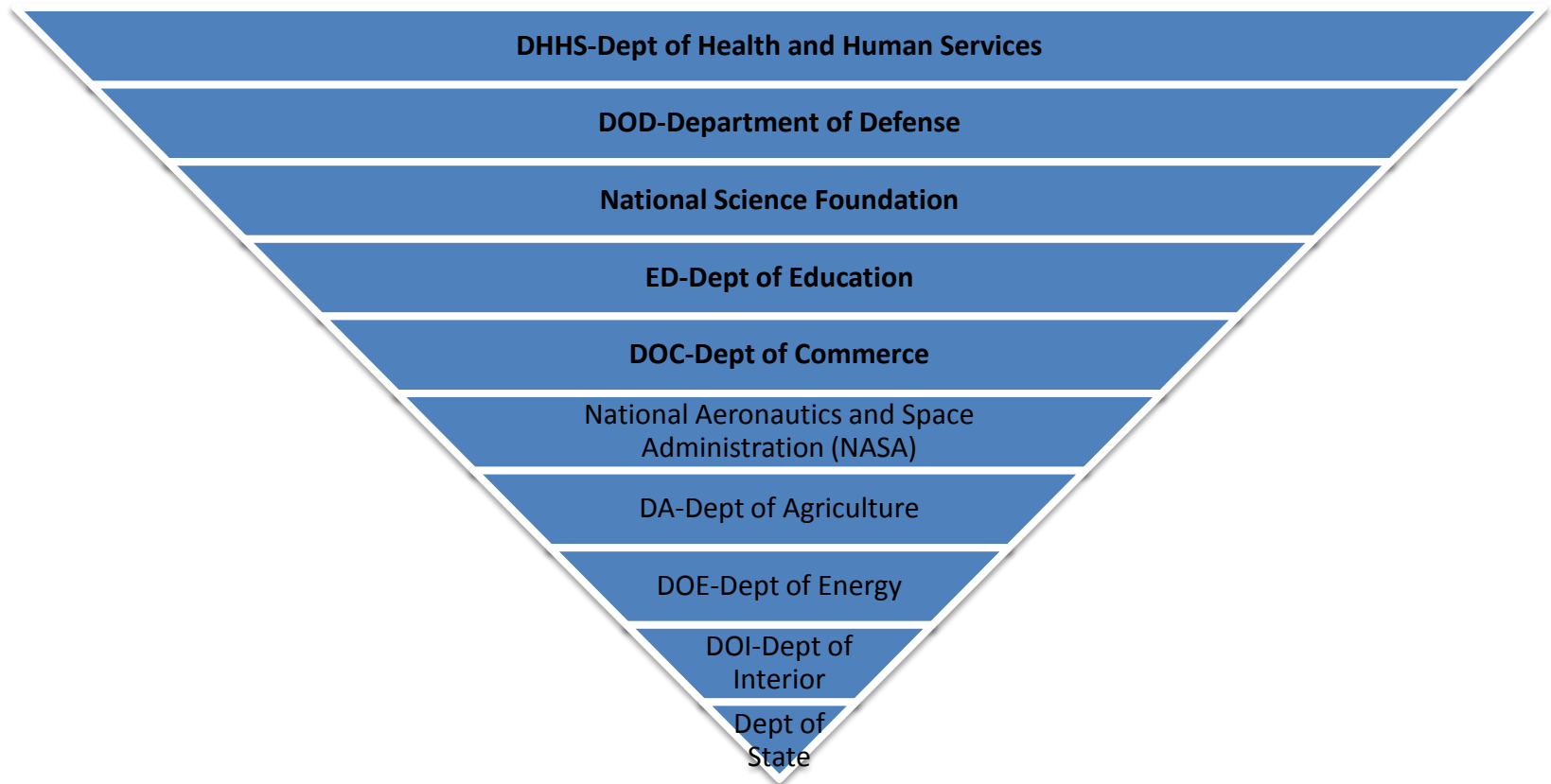

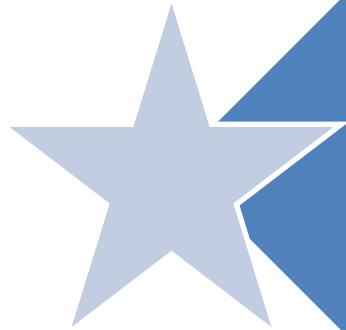

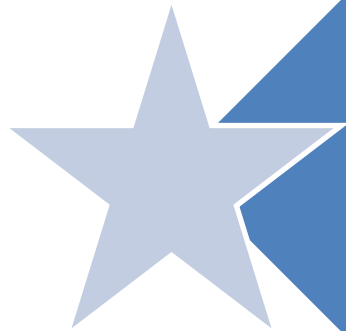
