**NEW UNIVERSITY OF HAWAI'I POLICY FOR UNDOCUMENTED STUDENTS**

You may qualify for Hawai'i resident tuition if you meet the following requirements:

1. Show you have lived in Hawai'i for 12 consecutive months prior to the first day of instruction and demonstrated intent to make Hawai'i your permanent residence (per HAR 20-4),
2. Attended a U.S. high school for at least 3 years and graduated from a U.S. high school (or attained the equivalent),
3. Filed an application for legal immigrant status, filed for Deferred Action, or submit a UH affidavit affirming the intent to file such application.
