

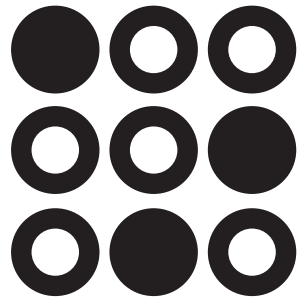
Instructional Technology Consultation

Media Equipment Loan Services

Media equipment is available to eligible UH Mānoa faculty and staff for academic and classroom support and is readily accessible from a central equipment pool (KUY 103). Most equipment is user-friendly and instruction usually takes just a few minutes. Equipment loan reservations may be made in person, by telephone, or via email.

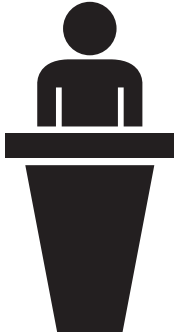

Campus Central Repair (CCR)

The CCR facility offers on-campus installation and repair for instructional media equipment owned by the university and offers preventive and general maintenance schedules for department-owned equipment. On-site services for equipment impractical to transport to CCR due to size or installation may be arranged. Services are available at nominal or no cost to eligible departments.

General Use Classrooms
